Its volumes have always proved to be of great value to genealogists and those interested in family history. It has a world-wide subscribership.

Publications can either be obtained through annual subscription, currently £25 (US\$50) for individuals and £30 (US\$60) for institutions, or purchased individually at the prices shown, which include packing and postage by economy mail. Contact us if you wish to pay extra for standard (air) mail.
